

How to Recreate Tiller's Foul Website*

1. Download "tillerwebsite.zip" from our website to you desktop and "Unzip" it. <http://www.overturnroe.com/tillerwebsite.zip>
 - a. If you have a site ready to host the files, just unzip the "tillerwebsite" file, then drag-and-drop the contents into your directory. The link paths in each file are set as relative links. You might have to tweek the source code a bit if you want to put the files in a sub-folder.
 - b. **!Warning!** If you do not have a website, do not understand what I just said above in 1a., are not the webmaster of your site, or are new to webhosting, then go to step 2 and diligently follow the directions. I will be giving examples marked "i.e."
2. Download "FileZilla" <http://filezilla-project.org/>
 - a. Or any other FTP client that you may or may not be familiar with.
 - b. Again, if you are new, just follow my recommendation.
3. Go to any "web hosting" site and buy a basic personal website account. (i.e. lunarpages.com, register.com, etc.)
 - a. I used <http://www.lunarpages.com> to host my "tiller" website.
 - b. When you register you don't have to buy any sort of "do it yourself" site builder. You will be using an FTP client to upload the site.

- c. You may or may not want to buy the “domain privacy” so that you can stay anonymous. You won’t need to buy any other add-ons they might try to sell you.
- d. *If you still don’t know what I’m talking about, don’t give up:*
 - i. Call lunarpage. 1-877-586-2772
 - ii. Tell them you want a “basic hosting plan”
 - iii. You can decide how long you want to keep the domain name
 - iv. Pay and wait for a confirmation email entitled:

Welcome to Lunarpages - Critical Account Info

- 4. Your hosting site will send you a confirmation email that includes a login username and password. They will also give you the “FTP host address.”
 - a. Take note of the: 1)username 2)password 3) FTP host address
 - b. i.e. **Lunarpage users:** it says in the email: **Account Information**
 - * Domain: tillerisabadman.com
 - * Username: tille24
 - * Password: DonkeyTail123
 - * Server: lasa
 - c. i.e. **Lunarpage users:** Scroll down to: **FTP Instructions**
 - i. **“FTP host address:** ns8.lunarbreeze.com (this can be used until propagation is complete) Or tillerisabadman.com (this can be used once propagation is complete)”

- ii. You want to take note of the first address mentioned in **“FTP host address”**
5. Install (if you haven't done so already) and open “Filezilla.” (see 1. Above)
6. Under the **“File”** menu select **“Site Manager...”** OR CTRL – S (win) command-S (mac)
 - a. You are making a **“New Site”**
7. **Box on left says**, Select Entry: My Sites: New site (just name the site after the domain you bought, i.e. tillerisabadman.com)
8. **Box on Right:** Under the **“General”** tab
 - a. Host = “FTP host address” (see 4.c. above) i.e. ns8.lunarbreeze.com
 - b. Port = blank
 - c. Servertype = FTP – File Transfer Protocol
 - d. Logontype = Normal (select normal, default is set at “Anonymous”)
 - e. User = “username” (see 4.b. above) i.e. tille24
 - f. Password: “password” (see 4.b. above) i.e. DonkeyTail123
9. **Box on Right:** Under the **“Advanced”** tab
 - a. Servertype = Default (Autodetect)
 - b. Bypass proxy = unchecked
 - c. Default local directory = desktop (this is the folder on your computer that contains the “tillerwebsite” file you downloaded in step 1.)

- d. Default remote directory = /public_html (you have to put it exactly as I just wrote: [forward slash] public [underscore] html) no spaces
10. **Box on Right:** Under the “**transfer settings**” tab
 - a. Transfer mode = Passive
 11. Click Connect (if you followed instructions 6 -9 perfectly you will have a connection. If it doesn’t connect, go back and re-check your work or try the help menu, or even call Filezilla technical support, or call Lunarpages support, or call the web savvy teenager you know down the street)
 12. On your Filezilla window you’ll see a bunch of chaos but look at the large box on the left (“Local Site”). You will recognize some of the files you have on your desktop or the folder you specified in 9.c. above.
 - a. Double-click the unzipped file called “tillerwebsite.”
 - b. Your box on the left should show the files (*bk1.html*, *chap.html*, *coun_elec.html*, etc.)
 13. The large box on the right is your “remote site: /public_html” There should only be a few things in there (*index.html*, *cgi-bin*, maybe some others)
 - a. Select all the contents of the “tillerwebsite” on the left, Drag-and-drop them to the right.
 - b. In the long box on the bottom of the screen it will show your progress
 - c. If there is a warning about replacing the “index.html” file or any file. Say “yes.”

14. Go to your browser and see if it worked.
 - a. If it doesn't work call, your webhosting technical support line and beg them to help you.
